The clever product concept transforms the bathroom into an oasis of well-being in next to no time and makes cleaning with water affordable for every home," says Martin Baumüller, Head of Group Division Marketing & Brands, when talking about the latest shower toilet from Geberit.

Versatile combinations

The AquaClean Tuma, which was designed by the renowned London-based industrial designer Christoph Behling, blends harmoniously into any bathroom environment and

makes it more aesthetically appealing. Thanks to its simple, elegant and extremely slim design, the new shower toilet also fits into small bathrooms and guest WCs, making the AquaClean Tuma a perfect solution for anyone who would like to enjoy the advantages of cleaning with water without the need for extensive conversions.

The compact dimensions and ease of installation of the AquaClean Tuma make flexible, individual solutions possible, and Geberit's latest shower toilet also surprises with its versatile combination options. The design cover is available in different colours and materials and can be combined, for example, with the actuator plates from Geberit and thus coordinated with the bathroom equipment and fittings.

Comfort-enhancing features

With the launch of the AquaClean Tuma, people are now able to enjoy a comfortable shower toilet that has a range of familiar and valued functions from other Geberit shower toilets – and all at an extremely attractive price. As a complete solution, the AquaClean Tuma features WhirlSpray shower technology, an odour extraction unit, a rimless WC ceramic appliance, a continuous flow heater that is specially designed for hard water and offers a permanent supply of warm water, an ergonomically designed, heatable WC seat, a warm-air dryer and an intuitive remote control. In addition to the remote control, an app featuring a range of additional functions is also available so that users can also operate the AquaClean Tuma via smartphone.

Easy installation

As is standard with Geberit appliances, the

AquaClean Tuma can also be comfortably and easily installed by a single plumber despite weighing over 25 kg in total. This is possible thanks to the well-designed packaging with integrated mounting aid. All the technical components are integrated into the functional unit above the WC ceramic appliance and can be easily accessed by the plumber and service technician. Needless to say, the shower toilet is compatible with all Geberit installation systems, the Monolith sanitary modules and the AquaClean design panel.

Pure and fresh, like a Swiss mountain river

Like with the shower toilet names "Sela" and "Mera", "Tuma" also stands for the purity and freshness of Swiss mountain streams flowing through the Swiss mountains. The river Tuma in the Canton of Graubünden is regarded as the source of the Rhine. It rises east of the Rossbodenstock and flows into the Anterior Rhine a few kilometres after leaving Lake Tuma. ←

Flexibility for tenants



As an alternative to the WC complete solution, the Geberit AquaClean Tuma is also available as a retrofittable WC enhancement solution that can be fitted to the WC ceramic appliances of various manufacturers without any problems. Because extensive conversion measures are not required to install it – only the water supply and mains connections need to be prepared – the AquaClean Tuma can also be very easily retrofitted in rented flats.

Quickly and easily installed

The new Geberit AquaClean Tuma impresses not only thanks to its versatility, it also stands out due to its extremely easy installation. The entire shower toilet technology is located in a compact functional unit above the ceramic appliance.



1. Mounting of the ceramic appliance

The ceramic appliance's wall fastening and the connections for water and electricity are hidden behind the toilet bowl. Although not visible, they are easily accessible for installation. Thanks to the well-designed packaging with integrated mounting aid, the AquaClean Tuma can be comfortably positioned at the correct installation height and fastened from above.



2. Installing the mounting plate

To prepare for the installation of the functional unit, the mounting plate is aligned on the ceramic appliance using the supplied installation template and then screwed on tightly.



3. Connecting to power and water supply

The electrical and water supply connections are connected and the ball valve opened.



4. Installation of the functional unit

The functional unit is then installed: the electrical and water supply connections are threaded back into the ceramic appliance, the functional unit is clicked into place on the mounting plate and the WC lid and design cover are installed.



5. Pairing and functional test

Before commissioning the AquaClean Tuma, the remote control is connected to the shower toilet and all the functions – such as the shower spray settings, odour extraction and WC seat heating – are tested via the control panel and the remote control.
