A WASHBASIN WITH NO CORNERS OR EDGES

The new Renova washbasin is modern, has a beautiful design and leaves a high-quality impression. It has an ample shelf surface as the tap hole bench is not lowered. The new straight sides of the ceramic sanitary appliance connects flush with the wall and offers a modern look. The trap can be elegantly concealed behind a ceramic half pedestal. The basin and tap are easy to install and, thanks to the special KeraTect® glaze, also easy to clean. The 60 and 65 cm washbasins have an impressive load-bearing capacity of 300 kg. The washbasin is available in four widths of 55 to 70 cm and also as a handrinse basin in three sizes.

ERGONOMICALLY SHAPED AND WITH AN OPTIMAL FIT

From April 2020, the Renova and Renova Plan bathroom series will also each feature a new bathtub made of sanitary acrylic. Highlights here include the following:

- ergonomically shaped back on the Renova model
- possibility of choosing between seven different sizes in order to tailor the bathtub to different bathroom spaces and body sizes, thus guaranteeing an optimal fit
- the long, wide and flat bathtub floors, thus providing a safe, comfortable shower surface on both bathtubs
- a rim at the foot of the bath that acts as both a spacious shelf surface and also as space for the tan

From a technical viewpoint, the new, patented telescopic foot set for adjusting the height of the bathtub is an intriguing proposition. This simplifies installation thanks to the wide adjustment range.

The new, modern design of the Renova washbasin can best be seen from above – among other aspects, the tap hole bench is no longer lowered and the side guide connects flush with the wall.

THE RIGHT MODEL FOR ALL CUSTOMER WISHES

The washbasins and toilets from the Geberit Selnova bathroom series are available in two different designs. Geberit Selnova has a round, organic design whilst Geberit Selnova Square is – as the name suggests – angular. The toilets are available as floor-standing and wall-hung versions, both in shrouded or semi-shrouded design. Models with or without flush rim are available, as are compact versions in the Selnova Comfort range.

20 NEW COMPACT MODELS

Selnova is now also available in compact form, meaning the ceramic sanitary appliances have a smaller projection. For the first time, the product range for 2020 includes 20 compact models in a timeless design for small bathrooms and guest WCs. The Selnova Compact range also includes two wall-hung Rimfree® toilets, two wall-hung bidets and 14 washbasins in widths of 40 to 65 cm.

EXPANDED FURNITURE CONCEPT

The existing furniture concept remains and has been added to as follows. New washbasin cabinets in a modern design are now available, featuring doors and drawers with soft closing in widths of 55, 60, 80 and 100 cm. These can be combined with a washbasin with a particularly narrow rim to form a high-quality ensemble consisting of furniture and ceramic sanitary appliance. In addition to the existing white high-gloss coated version, the range of colours has been expanded to include lava matt and a light and dark walnut design. Storage boxes are optionally available for the drawers. A modular, combinable low cabinet in two heights also offers added storage possibilities. The range is rounded off by two mirror cabinets with optional light.
